PAHO Sub-Regional Strategy Consultation– Barbados 7 May

Ministers and regional stakeholders provided their views on the Pan-American Health Organization’s (PAHO) Sub-regional Co-operation Strategy (SCS), which has significant links with the Caribbean Community’s regional *Caribbean Co-operation in Health Strategy Phase III (CCH3)* and with CARPHA. The strategy will cover the period up 2010- 2015 and its approach echoes CARPHA’s people-centered approach to public health. It will define the strategic technical areas that PAHO will support in the medium term and will assist PAHO to respond better to Caribbean sub-regional frameworks and initiatives including the creation of CARPHA.
